Academic Level Eligibility:

If you entered UCSD as a Freshman Student:

- Students in their 1st, 2nd, and 3rd years at UCSD are eligible and welcome to apply. Students in their 4th year and beyond at UCSD are not eligible.

If you entered UCSD as a Transfer Student:

- Students in their 1st year at UCSD are eligible and welcome to apply. Students in their 2nd year and beyond at UCSD are not eligible.

This is the required application for all students interested in applying for the FMPH 198 - Medical School Prep 101. To be eligible to apply, students must:

- 1. Have met the academic level eligibility listed above
- 2. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 3. Be available to meet remotely Wednesdays from 2-3:20pm (this course is not asynchronous)
- 4. Submit this application through Enrollment Authorization System (EASy) by the posted deadline
