FALL 2024 COURSE RECOMMENDATIONS (NFRS)

FALL 2024 PRIORITY COURSE RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Preparatory coursework including starting mathematics and chemistry courses, if needed: (AWP 3, 4A, or 4B; MATH 2, 3B, 3C, or 4C; CHEM 4, etc.)
 - o IMPORTANT NOTE: All students pursuing the PB26, PB27, PB31 Majors and/or Pre-Health track students should be enrolling in a Mathematics course this fall. Please see the **FA24 MATHEMATICS** Handout.
 - IMPORTANT NOTE: Most students pursuing the PB27, PB31 Majors and/or Pre-Health track students should be enrolling in a Chemistry course this fall. Please see the FA24 CHEMISTRY Handout.
- College GEs: MMW 11 (ERC), DOC 1 (TMC) and CAT 1 (Sixth) are only offered in the Fall; MCWP 40 and WCWP 10A are also offered in Fall, but may fill and are offered later this year (HUM 1, SYN 1, CCE 1 are offered in Winter)
 - Ask your College if you have any questions regarding College GEs that you could enroll in for FA24.
- PH 40. Introduction to Public Health (4 units)
 - Strongly recommended if can fit in FA24 schedule and seats are available.
 - Required for all Public Health Majors and must be taken at UC San Diego.
- PH 91. Gender and Public Health (4 units)
 - o Recommended if can fit in FA24 schedule and seats are available.
 - Counts towards LD PH Trending Topics Area for all BSPH Majors.
 - Must submit an <u>Enrollment Authorization System (EASy)</u> request to enroll or waitlist.
- PH 98. Living Well Doing Well: Dimensions of Well-Being and Staying Healthy to Succeed in College (2 units P/NP only)
 - This class is open to first- and second-year students and first quarter transfers. "Living Well Doing Well" will provide students a
 framework to encourage healthy choices to foster holistic well-being as they pursue their educational goals at UC San Diego. The 8
 Dimensions of Well-Being will be the focus of this course as students learn about campus and community partners and resources.
 - o Recommended if can fit in FA24 schedule and seats are available.
 - o Counts towards LD Public Health Elective Area for all BSPH Majors.
 - Must submit an Enrollment Authorization System (EASy) request to enroll or waitlist.
- Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Requirement (DEI)
 - A knowledge of diversity, equity, and inclusion is required of all students at UC San Diego. A list of approved courses can be found online (link).
 - o Ask your College if you have any questions regarding DEIs that you could enroll in for FA24.

 - o Required for all BSPH Majors.
- BILD 60. Exploring Issues of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion in Relation to Human Biology (4 units)
 - Counts towards LD Biology area for the following BSPH Majors (PB25, PB28, PB30).
 - o Counts towards Natural Science Area for the BSPH PB31 Major.
 - o Counts towards DEI requirement.
- HDS 60. Introduction to Statistical Analysis (4 units)
 - o Counts towards LD Quantitative Methods area for the following BSPH Majors (PB25, PB28, PB29, PB30, PB31).
- **PSYC 60**. Introduction to Statistics (4 units)
 - Counts towards LD Quantitative Methods area for the following BSPH Majors (PB25, PB28, PB29, PB30, PB31).
- ECON 1. Principles of Microeconomics (4 units)
 - o Good course to consider if pursuing BSPH PB30 Major as many UD PB30 Concentration UDEs require completion of course to enroll.
- POLI 11D. Introduction to Political Science: Comparative Politics (4 units)
 - o Good course to consider if pursuing BSPH PB30 Major as many UD PB30 Concentration UDEs require completion of course to enroll.

PLEASE NOTE: All students MUST be enrolled in at least 12 units (not including waitlisted courses). Do not waitlist for too many courses. Additionally, no student should be enrolled in more than 18 units. Until the first day of classes, students can only be enrolled and waitlisted for a combined max total of 19.5 units. Lastly, Public Health strongly recommends no more than 2-3 science/math/statistics courses in the fall. It is important to diversify your course schedule each quarter.
