FALL 2024 COURSE RECOMMENDATIONS (TRAN)

FALL 2024 COURSE RECOMMENDATIONS (do not enroll in any LD courses you have completed the course equivalent previously and/or that will satisfy a requirement area you have already completed):

- PH 40. Introduction to Public Health (4 units)
 - Required for all Public Health Majors and MUST be taken at UC San Diego. All incoming Declared and Prospective Public Health Transfer students MUST enroll for FA24 (if not enrolled in FMPH 40 this summer). Transfer students are only guaranteed two years at UC San Diego. Failure to enroll will prolong graduation by one academic year and may force student to have to change majors due to negatively affecting time-to-degree. Prospective Public Health Majors are no longer eligible for any of the BSPH Majors if PH 40 is not completed by the end of fall quarter.
- LD Statistics, if needed: (COGS 14B, HDS 60, MATH 11, or PSYC 60)
 - Required for all Public Health Majors. <u>All incoming Declared and Prospective Public Health Transfer students MUST enroll for FA24 (if have not completed one of the required statistics courses)</u>. Transfer students are only guaranteed two years at UC San Diego. Failure to enroll will prolong graduation by one academic year and may force student to have to change majors due to negatively affecting time-to-degree. Prospective Public Health Majors are no longer eligible for any of the BSPH Majors if statistics is not completed by the end of fall quarter.
 - MATH 11 required for the following two BSPH Majors (PB26, PB27).
- LD Research Methods course, if needed: (COGS 14A, PSYC 70, SOCI 60 PH 45 will be offered in a future quarter)
 - Required for all Public Health Majors.
 - Accepted in place of PH 45 with transfer equivalents included (for the 2024-25 school year ONLY)
- Remaining LD Public Health Science courses and/or remaining Pre-Health Track courses, if needed: (Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, etc.)
 - o IMPORTANT NOTE: All Pre-Health track students should review the **FA24 PRE-HEALTH** Handout. Students should attend zoom drop-in advising hours and/or reach out to Public Health in the <u>VAC</u> if unsure which Pre-Health courses they should be enrolling.
- College GEs: Calculus/Chemistry/Physics (Revelle), MCWP 125 (Muir), UD Disciplinary Breadth (TMC), WCWP 100 and UD Non-Contiguous (Warren), MMW 121 & 122 (ERC), CAT 125 (Sixth), SYN 100 (Seventh)
 - Ask your College if you have any questions regarding College GEs that you could enroll in for FA24.
- PH 91. Gender and Public Health (4 units)
 - o Recommended if can fit in FA24 schedule and seats are available.
 - Counts towards LD PH Trending Topics Area for all BSPH Majors.
 - Must submit an <u>Enrollment Authorization System (EASy)</u> request to enroll or waitlist.
- PH 98. Living Well Doing Well: Dimensions of Well-Being and Staying Healthy to Succeed in College (2 units P/NP only)
 - This class is open to first- and second-year students and first quarter transfers. "Living Well Doing Well" will provide students a
 framework to encourage healthy choices to foster holistic well-being as they pursue their educational goals at UC San Diego. The 8
 Dimensions of Well-Being will be the focus of this course as students learn about campus and community partners and resources.
 - o Recommended if can fit in FA24 schedule and seats are available.
 - Counts towards LD Public Health Elective Area for all BSPH Majors.
 - Must submit an <u>Enrollment Authorization System (EASy)</u> request to enroll or waitlist.
- PH 157. Race, Intersectionality, and Public Health (4 units)
 - Recommended if can fit in FA24 schedule and seats are available.
 - o Instructor has approved concurrent enrollment in PH 40 and PH 157 for any declared Public Health Transfer student or any student who completed FMPH 40 in the summer (this fall only). This course will explore the intersection of oppressions based on social identities such as race, ethnicity, socioeconomic class, gender, and citizenship status. This course will introduce the framework of intersectionality, with an emphasis on its use within the field of public health and explore and analyze how race and ethnicity are socially constructed and intersect with identities to influence health behavior and outcomes.
 - Counts towards PH UDE for all BSPH Majors.
 - Must submit an Enrollment Authorization System (EASy) request to enroll or waitlist.
- UDEs or Concentration UDEs
 - o Please see BSPH Major page for a complete list as UDEs vary based on BSPH Major (PB25, PB26, PB27, PB28, PB29, PB30, PB31)
- Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Requirement (DEI)
 - A knowledge of diversity, equity, and inclusion is required of all students at UC San Diego. A list of approved courses can be found online (<u>link</u>).
 - o Ask your College if you have any questions regarding DEIs that you could enroll in for FA24.

PLEASE NOTE: All students MUST be enrolled in at least 12 units (not including waitlisted courses). Do not waitlist for too many courses. Additionally, no student should be enrolled in more than 18 units. Until the first day of classes, students can only be enrolled and waitlisted for a combined max total of 19.5 units. Lastly, Public Health strongly recommends no more than 2-3 science/math/statistics courses in the fall. It is important to diversify your course schedule each quarter.
