The program welcomes students from all disciplines and backgrounds. We can accommodate up to 25 students, and will accept applications until October 17th* or until we reach the registration limit. If you are:

- concerned about the **climate crisis and related issues of justice, equity, health and wellbeing**, and
- interested in **hands-on, collaborative, community-based learning, research, and action**,

then apply to be part of the Climate Action Scholars Program in winter and spring, 2022. The class will meet on Friday mornings from 9 - 11:50am, with additional outings on occasional Friday afternoons and weekend days**.

The course series will be taught by [Leslie R. Lewis, PhD, MPH](#), a faculty member in the USP Dept, anthropologist, and a veteran of experiential, integrative, community-engaged learning.
