FA25 Course Recommendations for New Transfer Students

The following two courses MUST be completed by the end of FA25 in order to graduate on time.

- PH 40: Introduction to Public Health (there is no equivalent course at another institution)
- Statistics: COGS 14A, PSYC 60, HDS 60, or MATH 11*, if not completed at prior institution**
 - *MATH 11 is required for Biostatistics (PB26) and Climate & Environmental Sciences (PB27) concentrations and requires completion of MATH 10A/B or 20A/B
 - **If prior institution is not a California Community College with listed equivalents on <u>assist.org</u>, a student MUST petition their Statistics course THIS SUMMER with Psychology or Math for equivalency; approval is not guaranteed.
