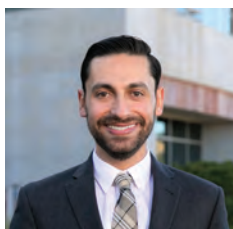


Marcus M. Carreon, MsC

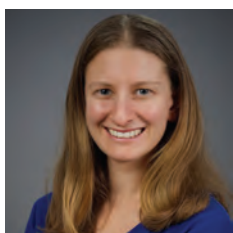


Ernesto Ramirez, PhD, MS
