Considering Summer School? Consider Public Health!

Many transfer students decide to take Summer classes at UC San Diego. You may want to study abroad next Fall, earn a minor, complete pre-health prerequisites, graduate a quarter early, or maybe just want to get started as a UC San Diego student right away. We are offering a number of Public Health courses this summer, most of them remotely, to help you meet your goal.

Summer Session courses are 5 weeks each, so we recommend no more than 2 classes per session. All Summer 2025 Upper Division Public Health courses require concurrent or prior enrollment in PH 40: Introduction to Public Health.

Take Public Health classes this summer!

SUMMER SESSION 1 (6/30-8/2)

•PH 40: Introduction to Public Health (T/Th 11 am - 1:50 pm, REMOTE)

Open to all but recommended for incoming transfer students, required for all majors. Session 1 enrollment in PH 40 allows students to enroll in PH 110 during Summer Session 2, and a limited number of seats will be available in PH 101/102 in FA25 for new transfer students who take PH 40 during the summer.

- •PH 91: Topics in Public Health: Health Promotion (M/W 11 am 1:50 pm, REMOTE) Open to all, meets Lower Division Trending Topics or Lower Division Elective requirements for majors
- •PH 161: Clinical Nutrition (T/Th 2-4:50 pm, REMOTE)

 Open to transfer students concurrently enrolled in PH 40, meets Upper Division Public Health Elective requirements

SUMMER SESSION 2 (8/4-9/6)

•PH 40: Introduction to Public Health (T/Th 2-4:50 pm, REMOTE)

Open to all but recommended for incoming transfer students, required for all majors. A limited number of seats will be available in PH 101/102 in FA25 for new transfer students who take PH 40 during the summer.

- Open to students who will have completed PH 40 in Summer Session 1, required for all majors

Students may also wish to consider taking Lower Division Biology or Upper Division Elective courses.

Seats still available in all listed courses as of 6/11.

Students interested in applying to switch into a Public Health major (from a major outside the School of Public Health) must complete all Major Entry requirements by the end of Fall 2025 to be eligible.

All majors in the Herbert Wertheim School of Public Health require completion of PH 40, BILD 3, and a Statistics class, at minimum.

New students must apply to enroll in Summer Session. Applications must be completed prior to registration in Summer classes.
