Dear Current and Prospective Public Health Majors:

PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE READ THIS ENTIRE EMAIL!!!

We realize that this is a long email, but it is extremely important. It contains instructions that are critical to registering for Winter 2024 FMPH classes.

As you may know, Winter 2024 pass is just around the corner. The Winter 2024 Schedule of Classes will post on **November 8th**. Due to high demand for our courses, **you will need to follow the instructions listed below**.

It is VERY IMPORTANT that you check your <u>VAC</u> and UCSD email regularly. The department will be sending out timesensitive updates. If you miss these updates, you may end up not getting seats in classes you need.

INSTRUCTIONS

Please check out our <u>Advising Calendar</u> for up-to-date advising availability. If you are unable to come in during zoom drop-in advising hours, please send any questions you have through the <u>VAC</u>. <u>Queries received via phone or email will not receive a response</u>.

NOTE REGARDING USP 143:

Our department has no control over pass for USP 143. If you plan to graduate in 2024 and have not yet taken USP 143, you MUST register for USP 143 during your first pass. If you have any problems enrolling in first pass, please contact the USP Department ASAP through the VAC. The USP Department does not respond to requests via phone or email.

NOTE REGARDING ALL FMPH COURSES:

If you are interested in enrolling in a FMPH course that is full during your first pass, you should waitlist at the very beginning of second pass. The campus waitlist will be prioritized, and the department will keep an internal waitlist. All remaining seats will be filled using the internal waitlist, so please make sure to waitlist at the very beginning of second pass and wait for our VAC message before switching your schedule. We will message all waitlisted students to let them know if we have seats for them or if we have placed them on our internal waitlist for the course within 2 weeks after second pass has started. All students who were authorized to enroll in a FMPH course MUST enroll in first pass for priority enrollment unless clearance clearly states you can enroll in second pass (which is rare).

IN-PERSON VERSUS REMOTE FMPH INSTRUCTION:

All FMPH courses will be in-person for Winter 2024, we will not be offering any remote or asynchronous instruction options. Courses that offer an in-person option will indicate a campus classroom. All remote courses will list RCLAS indicating the course will be taught remotely.

FMPH COURSE DETAILS & INFORMATION

FMPH 40: Tuesday/Thursday 9:30-10:50am with Dr. Anderson

- Prerequisites: none.

70 seats have been released for first pass. All other students interested in enrolling in FMPH 40 should waitlist at the very beginning of second pass once the course is full. NOTE for non-Public Health Majors: If you are pursuing one of our Public Health Majors, please make sure to review our <u>Public Health Entry Requirement</u> on our website. All deadlines must be met to be eligible, there are no exceptions to the listed deadlines.

FMPH 50: Tuesday/Thursday 8-9:20am with Dr. Reddy

- Prerequisites: none.

180 seats have been released. If you are planning on graduating this academic year and have not yet completed FMPH 50, you MUST enroll in FMPH 50 in WINTER 2024 to graduate in Spring/Summer 2024. We will not be offering FMPH 50 in the spring. If you have problems getting into FMPH 50 during your first pass, please send the department a VAC message ASAP (and during your first pass) to let us know. All other students interested in enrolling in FMPH 50 should waitlist at the very beginning of second pass once the course is full.

FMPH 101: Monday/Wednesday/Friday 10-10:50am with Dr. Tan & Tuesday/Thursday 12:30-1:50pm with Dr. Miller

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40, PSYC 60 or MATH 11 or COGS 14B or HDS 60. Open to JR, SR standing. Students with SO Standing must submit an <u>Enrollment Authorization System (EASy)</u> to enroll.

110 seats have been released for first pass. All seats have been released. All other students interested in enrolling in FMPH 101 should waitlist at the very beginning of second pass once the course is full.

FMPH 102: Tuesday/Thursday 5-6:20pm with Dr. Rana

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40, PSYC 60 or MATH 11 or COGS 14B or HDS 60. Open to JR, SR standing. Students with SO Standing must submit an Enrollment Authorization System (EASy) to enroll.

55 seats have been released for first pass. All other students interested in enrolling in FMPH 102 should waitlist at the very beginning of second pass once the course is full.

FMPH 110: Tuesday/Thursday: 8-9:20am and 9:30-10:50am with Dr. Hartman

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40. Open to SO, JR, SR standing.

115 seats have been released for first pass. All other students interested in enrolling in FMPH 110 should waitlist at the very beginning of second pass once the course is full.

FMPH 120: Tuesday/Thursday 2-3:20pm with Dr. Nguyen

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40. Open to JR, SR standing. Students with SO Standing must submit an <u>Enrollment Authorization</u> System (EASy) to enroll.

65 seats have been released for first pass. FMPH 120 is a prerequisite for FMPH 193. We have a couple Capstone Instructors who will allow students to enroll in FMPH 120 and FMPH 193 concurrently. If you are planning on enrolling in FMPH 193 this winter and have not yet completed FMPH 120, you MUST enroll in FMPH 120 in WINTER 2024 to graduate in Spring/Summer 2024. If you have problems getting into FMPH 120 during your first pass, please send the department a VAC message ASAP (and during first pass) to let us know. All other students interested in enrolling in FMPH 120 should waitlist at the very beginning of second pass once the course is full.

FMPH 130: Tuesday/Thursday 12:30-1:50pm with Dr. Kayser

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40, FMPH 101. Open to JR, SR standing.

70 seats have been released for first pass. All other students interested in enrolling in FMPH 130 should waitlist at the very beginning of second pass once the course is full.

USP 143: Tuesday/Thursday: 9:30-10:50am with Dr. Hinds

- Prerequisites: none. Open to JR, SR standing.

The BSPH Program has no control over pass for USP 143. If you plan to graduate in 2024 and have not yet taken USP 143, you <u>MUST register for USP 143 during your first pass</u>. If you have any problems enrolling in first pass, please contact the USP Department ASAP through the <u>VAC</u>. The USP Department does not respond to requests via phone or email.

FMPH 161: Tuesday/Thursday 9:30-10:50am with Dr. Zoumas

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40. Open to SO, JR, SR standing.

35 seats have been released for first pass. If all seats are filled during first pass, students interested in enrolling in FMPH 161 should waitlist at the very beginning of second pass once the course is full. As a reminder, one FMPH UDE is required for all Public Health majors.

FMPH 191 "Climate Change as a Public Health Crisis": (A00) Tuesday/Thursday 3:30-4:50pm with Dr. Mara Harrell

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40 & Department Approval to Enroll. Open to SO, JR, SR standing. — Please submit your preauthorization request via the <u>Preauthorization System</u> for approval to enroll for winter quarter. One FMPH UDE is required for all Public Health majors thus FMPH 191 "Climate Change as a Public Health Crisis" is a great opportunity to complete your major requirement in a small class setting.

FMPH 191 "Immunizations and Public Health": (B00) Tuesday/Thursday 5-6:20pm with Dr. Margaret Ryan

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40 & Department Approval to Enroll. Open to SO, JR, SR standing. — Please submit your preauthorization request via the <u>Preauthorization System</u> for approval to enroll for winter quarter. One FMPH UDE is required for all Public Health majors thus FMPH 191 "Immunizations and Public Health" is a great opportunity to complete your major requirement in a small class setting.

FMPH 193 (Public Health Capstone I)

This class is only for students who have completed FMPH 40, FMPH 101, FMPH 102, FMPH 110, and FMPH 120 and are planning on graduating in 2024. We have a couple Capstone Instructors who will allow students to enroll in FMPH 120 and FMPH 193 concurrently, but all other courses MUST be completed by the end of fall 2023 to be eligible to enroll. There are six FMPH 193 sections in Winter 2024 and are asking all eligible students to rank which FMPH 193 class they would prefer to take. Students MUST rank all six sections for preferences to be considered.

Please fill out this <u>WI24 FMPH 193: Public Health Capstone I - Course Day/Time Preferences Form</u> between 11/8 and 11/19. You MUST fill out the preference form by November 19th by 11:59pm for preference consideration of FMPH 193 course day/time.

All eligible students will be cleared to enroll in one FMPH 193 section during second pass (after second pass begins). Students will be messaged in the VAC to let students know which section they have been cleared for. DO NOT submit EASy requests to enroll in FMPH 193, all EASy requests to enroll in FMPH 193 will be DENIED. It takes us longer to assign students to FMPH 193 sections if we keep having to review EASy requests so please help us by being patient. FINAL NOTE: The FMPH 193 day/time and instructor you are placed into will be the same for FMPH 194 in SP24. As a reminder the FMPH 194 final exam for SP24 will fall on a Saturday. All Capstone students are required to attend their FMPH 194 final exam Poster Session in-person, there are no exceptions.

 - NOTE: Section overlaps with USP 143; students MUST rank as 6th choice if still need USP 143 and plan on enrolling concurrently with FMPH 193.

- FMPH 193 C00 T/R 11-12:20pm (Dr. Nguyen)
- FMPH 193 D00 W 5-7:50pm (Dr. Stone)
- FMPH 193 E00 T/R 3:30-4:50pm (Dr. White)
- FMPH 193 F00 T/R 8-9:20am (Dr. Zoumas)

FINAL ITEMS:
