Over the course of the next few months, you will receive a number of messages from our office, both via e-mail and in the <u>Virtual Advising Center</u>. Our goal is to prepare you for your time as a student here at UC San Diego and in the School of Public Health.

Today we'd like you to take a look at our **New Student Guide**, which is intended to be an introduction to our program, the majors, and your timeline for this summer. Additionally, we invite you to take a look around our <u>website</u>, which is packed with helpful information.

On Wednesday, July 9th, we encourage you to register for our <u>online Orientation modules</u>. Of course, you can get started with these courses this Summer - we are offering PH 40 remotely in both Summer Sessions 1 and 2, along with a number of other required and elective courses for the major. Transfer students who take PH 40 this summer will be guaranteed a spot in one of our Core classes (PH 101, 110, or 120/120R) this fall, if they follow enrollment instructions.
