Academic Level Eligibility:

WI25 and SP25 - Open to all students who entered UCSD in FA24:

- First-year freshmen students and first-year transfer students who entered UCSD in FA24 and have a UC GPA of a 2.5 or higher are eligible and welcome to apply for WI25 and SP25. All other students are not eligible.

To be eligible to apply, students must:

- 1. Have met the academic level eligibility listed above for the quarter applying
- 2. Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- 3. Be available to meet in-person on Wednesdays from 11-11:50am (this course is not asynchronous)
- 4. Submit this application through Enrollment Authorization System (EASy) by the posted deadline
