

IMPORTANT: Enrollment in FMPH Courses for Winter 2023

Dear Current and Prospective Public Health Majors:

PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE READ THIS ENTIRE EMAIL!!!

We realize that this is a long email, but it is extremely important. It contains instructions that are critical to registering for Winter 2023 FMPH classes.

Second Registration for Winter 2022 begins on November 14th. Due to high demand for our courses, **you will need to follow the instructions listed below.**

It is VERY IMPORTANT that you check your [VAC](#) and UCSD email regularly. The department will be sending out time-sensitive updates. If you miss these updates, you may end up not getting seats in classes you need.

Please check out our [Advising Calendar](#) for up-to-date advising availability. If you are unable to come in during zoom drop-in advising hours, please send any questions you have through the [VAC](#). **Queries received via phone or email will not receive a response.**

NOTE REGARDING USP 143:

Our department has no control over registration for USP 143. If you plan to graduate in 2023 and have not yet taken USP 143, you **MUST register for USP 143 during your first registration.** If you have any problems enrolling in first registration, please contact the **USP Department ASAP** through the [VAC](#). The USP Department does not respond to requests via phone or email.

NOTE REGARDING ALL FMPH COURSES:

If you are interested in enrolling in a FMPH course that is full during your first registration, you should waitlist at the very beginning of second registration. The campus waitlist will be prioritized, and the department will keep an internal waitlist. All remaining seats will be filled using the internal waitlist, so please make sure to waitlist at the very beginning of second registration and wait for our [VAC](#) message before switching your schedule. We will message all waitlisted students to let them know if we have seats for them or if we have placed them on our internal waitlist for the course within 2 weeks after **second** registration has started. **All students who were authorized to enroll in a FMPH course MUST enroll in first registration for priority enrollment.**

IN-PERSON VERSUS REMOTE FMPH INSTRUCTION:

All FMPH courses will be in-person for Winter 2023, we will not be offering any remote or asynchronous instruction options. Courses that offer an in-person option will indicate a campus classroom. All remote courses will list **RCLAS** indicating the course will be taught remotely.

FMPH 40: Tuesday/Thursday 12:30-1:50pm with Dr. Britta Larsen

- Prerequisites: none. Open to FR, SO, JR standing. Students with SR Standing must submit an [Enrollment Authorization System \(EASy\)](#) to enroll.

All seats have been released. All students interested in enrolling in FMPH 40 should waitlist at the very beginning of second registration if the class is full.

IMPORTANT: Enrollment in FMPH Courses for Winter 2023

FMPH 50: Tuesday/Thursday 8-9:20am with Dr. Divya Reddy

- Prerequisites: none. Open to FR, SO, JR standing. Students with SR Standing must submit an [Enrollment Authorization System \(EASy\)](#) to enroll.

All seats have been released. If you are planning on graduating next academic year and have not yet completed FMPH 50, you MUST enroll in FMPH 50 in **WINTER 2023** to graduate in Spring/Summer 2024. If you have problems getting into FMPH 50 during your first registration, please send the department a [VAC](#) message ASAP to let us know. All students interested in enrolling in FMPH 50 should waitlist at the very beginning of second registration if the class is full.

FMPH 101: Tuesday/Thursday 12:30-1:50pm and 2-3:20pm with Dr. Marva Seifert

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40, PSYC 60 or MATH 11 or COGS 14B or HDS 60. Open to JR, SR standing. Students with SO Standing must submit an [Enrollment Authorization System \(EASy\)](#) to enroll.

All seats have been released. All students interested in enrolling in FMPH 101 should waitlist at the very beginning of second registration if the class is full.

FMPH 102: Monday/Wednesday 2-3:20pm with Dr. Brinda Rana

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40, PSYC 60 or MATH 11 or COGS 14B or HDS 60. Open to JR, SR standing. Students with SO Standing must submit an [Enrollment Authorization System \(EASy\)](#) to enroll.

All seats have been released. All students interested in enrolling in FMPH 102 should waitlist at the very beginning of second registration if the class is full.

FMPH 110: Tuesday/Thursday: 9:30-10:50am and 11-12:20pm with Dr. Sheri Hartman

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40. Open to SO, JR, SR standing.

All seats have been released. All students interested in enrolling in FMPH 110 should waitlist at the very beginning of second registration if the class is full.

FMPH 120: Tuesday/Thursday 11-12:20pm with Dr. France Nguyen

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40. Open to JR, SR standing. Students with SO Standing must submit an [Enrollment Authorization System \(EASy\)](#) to enroll.

All seats have been released. FMPH 120 is a prerequisite for FMPH 194. If you are planning on enrolling in FMPH 193 this winter and have not yet completed FMPH 120, you MUST enroll in FMPH 120 in **WINTER 2023** to graduate in Spring/Summer 2023. If you have problems getting into FMPH 120 during your first registration, please send the department a [VAC](#) message ASAP to let us know. All students interested in enrolling in FMPH 120 should waitlist at the very beginning of second registration if the class is full.

FMPH 130: Tuesday/Thursday 2-3:20pm with Dr. Georgia Kayser

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40, FMPH 101. Open to JR, SR standing.

All seats have been released. All students interested in enrolling in FMPH 130 should waitlist at the very beginning of second registration if the class is full.

USP 143: Tuesday/Thursday: 9:30-10:50am with Dr. Juli Hinds

- Prerequisites: none. Open to JR, SR standing.

Our department has no control over registration for USP 143. If you plan to graduate in 2023 and have not yet taken USP 143, you MUST register for USP 143 during your first registration. If you have any problems enrolling in first registration, please contact the USP Department ASAP through the [VAC](#). The USP Department does not respond to requests via phone or email.

FMPH 161: Tuesday/Thursday 8-9:20am with Dr. Christine Zoumas

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40. Open to SO, JR, SR standing.

All seats have been released. All students interested in enrolling in FMPH 161 should waitlist at the very beginning of second registration if the class is full. As a reminder, one FMPH UDE is required for all Public Health majors.

FMPH 191 "Racism as a Public Health Crisis": (A00) Tuesday/Thursday 3:30-4:50pm with Dr. Mara Harrell

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40 & Department Approval to Enroll. Open to SO, JR, SR standing. – Please submit your preauthorization request via the [Preauthorization System](#) for approval to enroll for winter quarter registration. One FMPH UDE is required for all Public Health majors thus FMPH 191 “Racism as a Public Health Crisis” is a great opportunity to complete your major requirement in a small class setting.

FMPH 191 "Health Economics and Health Policy": (B00) Tuesday/Thursday 11-12:20pm with Dr. Yuyan Shi

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40 & Department Approval to Enroll. Open to SO, JR, SR standing. – Please submit your preauthorization request via the [Preauthorization System](#) for approval to enroll for winter quarter registration. One FMPH UDE is required for all Public Health majors thus FMPH 191 “Health Economics and Health Policy” is a great opportunity to complete your major requirement in a small class setting.

FMPH 191 "Immunizations and Public Health": (C00) Tuesday/Thursday 5-6:20pm with Dr. Margaret Ryan

- Prerequisites: FMPH 40 & Department Approval to Enroll. Open to SO, JR, SR standing. – Please submit your preauthorization request via the [Preauthorization System](#) for approval to enroll for winter quarter registration. One FMPH UDE is required for all Public Health majors thus FMPH 191 “Immunizations and Public Health” is a great opportunity to complete your major requirement in a small class setting.

FMPH 193 (Public Health Capstone I)

This class is only for students who have completed FMPH 40, FMPH 50, FMPH 101, FMPH 102, and FMPH 110 and are planning on graduating in 2023. We will have six FMPH 193 sections in Winter 2023 and asked all eligible students to rank which FMPH 193 class they would prefer to take. Students MUST rank all six sections for preferences to be considered. **All students who filled out the FMPH 193 Preference Form with 6 different section ranked options by November 16th will be cleared to enroll in FMPH 193 on/by December 5th.** If you still wish to waitlist for your 1st choice section, have W123 schedule changes that affect the FMPH 193 section you wish to be enrolled in, or forgot to fill out the FMPH 193 Course Day/Time Preferences before the deadline - you can submit a request through the [\(WAITLIST\) W123 FMPH 193: Public Health Capstone I - Course Day/Time Preferences Form \(Form will open after all section placements\)](#). NOTE: The FMPH 193 day/time and instructor you are placed into will be the same for FMPH 194 in SP23. As a reminder the FMPH 194 final exam for SP23 typically falls on a Saturday. All Capstone students are required to attend their FMPH 194 final exam Poster Session in-person, there are no exceptions.

FINAL ITEMS:

Lastly, we recognize that our advising hours will be limited prior to winter enrollment. However, we will also be available on the [VAC](#) to answer questions. Please contact us ASAP with any registration questions you may have to ensure that your questions are answered in time for first registration.

As a reminder our office will be closed Monday, November 21st through Friday, November 25th. We will leave the [VAC](#) open for students to ask questions and answer any questions in the order received beginning on Monday, November 28th.
